**SUPPLY** Thanks to a combination of good planning and precipitation, the current water supply outlook is secure. Ample rain this winter filled reservoirs and reduced use by allowing customers to stop irrigating for months. The District's successful efforts to procure drought resilient options such as desalinated water have also increased our local, reliable supplies.

**DEMAND** Rain or shine, all customers share in the responsibility to make water supplies last as intended. Efficient water use remains essential to ensure water will be available when we need it most. High quality water is a precious, indispensable resource and even under the best of conditions there simply isn't enough to waste.

**ACTION** We're in this together. Customer water conservation efforts are supported through a variety of programs including rebates and free on-site water efficiency check-ups. Additionally, the District is constantly working to extend water supplies with infrastructure projects ranging from replacing aging pipelines and improving reservoir storage to updating meters and treatment facilities.
